CALL TO ORDER

1. PRESIDENT'S REPORT – Anthony Woodruff, MD

A Overall Report of Society

President Anthony Woodruff called the meeting to order at 10:30 AM. It was established that a total of 40 members were present, representing a quorum of the membership. Dr. Woodruff welcomed and thanked the attendees for their participation of the 46th Meeting. He also thanked the DeSantis Management Group for their continued management of AZUS and coordination of a successful 2019 meeting.

B Approval of Minutes, 2018 Meeting

Dr. Woodruff asked the membership to review the 2018 minutes and present any corrections. There being none, a motion to approve the 2018 Business Minutes was moved, seconded and carried.

Dr. Woodruff reviewed the highlights and goals of the Arizona Urological Society meetings:

- Continue to deliver relevant educational content to our members – including 8.5 CME for this meeting. The state of the art lectures courses deliver excellent information.
- Continue the importance of our local networking, meet with our colleagues as well as industry. Networking with community, industry and academics.
- Maintain our advocacy, lobbying and health policy on behalf of membership. He thanked Jason Jameson for his involvement on behalf of the AZUS.
- Continue to foster resident participation from Univ. of Arizona and Mayo – he noted many of the residents stay in Arizona after graduation and most likely maintain their involvement with the AZUS.
- Keep the programs flexible, while creating more atmosphere and fun during the meetings.
- Always strive to increase attendance at meetings.

Dr. Woodruff reviewed the following:

- Current officer list. Noting a need for a Northern AZ regional representative, **Dr. Jeff Sanwick** was nominated for the position, with his acceptance.
- Exhibitor list in attendance at this meeting and thanked them for their participation. It was noted that our exhibitor participation increased from 2018 – mainly due to more time and activity for the exhibitors to interact with physicians.
- Registration Report noting the updated figures since July 29:
 - Total Physicians/Health Professionals: 64
 - Total Exhibitors/Guest/Staff: 78
 - Grand Total: 142
- List of new members – he asked any of those listed to stand.

A motion to approve the President's Report was moved, seconded and carried.

2. SECRETARY/TREASURER'S REPORT – Erik Castle, MD

Dr. Castle reported the following:

- Financial Report:
 - Overall the society is financially solvent. A great attendance at this meeting.
 - Our funds in the bank have decreased \$15,000 – due to spending a more on the quality of the meetings to create more value for participants.
 - The dues income remains stable and up for 2018.
 - As noted earlier exhibit income is up for 2019 as we provided better value in 2018 and time, which resulted in a better attendance this year.
- As of December 31, 2018, the Balance Sheet shows total assets were over \$78,941. He noted on the Profit & Loss Statement that there was a loss of almost \$15,000 in 2018. This was due primarily to increasing the quality of the meeting and that year showed a decrease in industry support. Otherwise the society is very conservative and budgets to grow its financial base and reserves.
- Dues Report: The membership breakdown that included physicians, residents, and health professionals. Of the 97 dues paying members, 3 were free as new members, 61 were paid and 33 remain unpaid and we gained 16 new members for this dues period. Total dues revenue for the period was \$11,410.
- Audit Committee Report: Dr. Matthew Gretzer, who had reviewed the 2018 tax returns and other official records, stated they were completed and filed on-time. He said that the society is in good order and properly managed.

A motion to approve the Secretary/Treasurer Report was moved, seconded and carried.

3. REGIONAL REPRESENTATIVE REPORTS

Tucson: Dr. Chris Twiss reported that the Urology division of the University of Arizona is now a full department, an achievement they have worked on for 50 years. No other reports were made.

4. PROGRAM CHAIRMAN'S REPORT – Chris Twiss, MD

Dr. Twiss reported:

- The state of the art lectures presented by invited speaker Dr. Lynn Stothers were outstanding. This is an example of how a smaller meeting like the AZUS offers topics that we would not have time for at the larger meeting.
- The courses and content were valuable with take home messages for our attendees.
- The evaluations of the 2018 meeting reflected a high rating. We will most likely continue with this format again next year.

A motion to approve the Report of the Program Committee Chairman was moved, seconded and carried.

5. OLD / NEW BUSINESS

- a. A Distinguished Member plaque of recognition was awarded to Dr. Martin Dresner, followed by applause for his many accomplishments.
- b. Dr. Eric Zeidman was recognized as the Representative to the AUA Board of Directors.
- c. The Nominating Committee nominated **Dr. Benjamin Lee** for WSAUA Board of Director Alternate (2019-2021), which he accepted.
- d. Dr. Martin Dresner, historian, presented the necrology report noting the passing of charter member Dr. Theodore Mobley, after which a moment of silence was held in his memory.
- e. **ArMa/AHAC:** Affiliation with Arizona Medical Assn / Arizona Healthcare Advocacy Coalition (“AHAC”) - A proposal from AHAC to join an advocacy coalition of specialty societies was discussed and reviewed. The goal of the AHAC is to have physicians more effectively compete in the policymaking process and political process. Membership was approved at the “general level” with annual dues of \$2,500. It was noted that AZUS membership would in effect provide AZUS members a great benefit consistent with AZUS mission. AHAC will broadly support physician-led and patient-centric advocacy efforts in Arizona focused on issues such as evidence-based medicine, best practices, public health improvement, professional liability costs, reducing administrative burdens, improving health plan coverage, and addressing scope of practice expansion requests. It will provide overarching support for its members’ lobbying activities through strategic communication including social media advocacy, targeted polling and surveys, Request to Speak engagement, and other communication/advocacy efforts.

In Memoriam, Distinguished Member Martin L. Dresner, MD, FACS, 1940-2020

Dr Martin Dresner, has passed away on December 20, 2020, Tucson, AZ. Dr Dresner was a loyal and very active member of many medical associations, currently retired yet rarely ever missed a meeting. A well-versed urologist, he utilized his extraordinary expertise to serve as a Program Director of the Urology Section within Southern Arizona VA Health Care System in Tucson, Arizona. With 45 years of experience in the challenging branch of urology, Dr. Dresner has been highly regarded for his knowledge and skills in the diagnosis, prevention, and treatment of problems of the male and female urinary tract and the male reproductive organs. His career had military service origins for which he was rewarded.

He was drafted into the Army after internship at Abington Memorial Hospital and served in Vietnam with the First Air Cavalry Division. He holds significant military awards, including the Legion of Merit, Bronze Star (meritorious), Air Medal, U.S. & Vietnamese airborne wings, Combat Medical Badge, and the Commander's Coin for Excellence. He received the Vietnam Campaign and Vietnam Service medals. He was designated with the coveted "A" prefix denoting professorial status and the Order of Military Medical Merit. Dr. Dresner has served in the U.S. Army between 1966 and 1994, when he retired as a Colonel. While serving, he received the Henry M. and M. Paige Laughlin Lifetime Educator award by Ursinus College and was the recipient of the prestigious Presidential Citation by the American Urological Association in 2015. He was also an Adjunct Associate Professor of Surgery at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences. He worked full time training urology residents at the University of Arizona and the Southern Arizona VA Healthcare System. In that capacity, he has received "Best Teacher" awards four times from University of Arizona urology residents. He also received the top surgical teacher award from the senior medical students at the John A. Burns School of Medicine at the University of Hawaii in 1994. After medical school, he completed his residency in general surgery at Martin Army Community Hospital at Ft. Benning, Georgia. He completed urology residency at Letterman General Hospital in San Francisco, followed by a fellowship in pediatric urology at the Children's Memorial Hospital in Chicago. His clinical specialties are urology and pediatric urology. He is proud of the fact that he was the first Military Urologist to complete a fellowship program in Pediatrics. He has also been involved in his local veterans post, part of the Jewish War Veterans of the United States of America. He is serving as Senior Vice Commander and has for eight years in the past. He has been a member and served for three years as head of the City of Tucson Veterans Affairs Committee. He retired in 1994 with 33.5 years of military service before his current positions with the VA and University of Arizona Hospitals.

He has many works published and attributes his success to dedication, hard work, love of the medical profession and excellent colleagues. He enjoyed reading the Journal of Urology and is passionate about music, jazz, and spending time with his grandchildren and best friend, Ellen. Affectionately called "Dr. Jazz" if a piano was accessible on the hotel floor, Dr Dresner could be heard playing popular songs to everyone's delight at the many meetings he attended. A friendly, lively and kind person who loved to share his vast experiences, Marty will be greatly missed.

NECROLOGY REPORT – Ted Mobley, MD Joined AZUS 1987

Dr. Theodore “Ted” Lee Mobley, age 84, of Scottsdale, passed away on June 13, 2019, from leukemia

Dr. Mobley was a charter member of the AZUS and co-founder of the Phoenix Urological Society.

Dr. Mobley was born on September 14, 1934, in Los Angeles, California, as the second of eight children of James Faust Mobley and Mary Lucille Martin Mobley. He grew up in Southern California, attending North Hollywood High School. He went to UC Santa Barbara, 1952-55, and graduated from UCLA in 1956. He got his medical degree from USC’s Keck School of Medicine in 1959. He did his general residency at Johns Hopkins University, 1960-61, and his residency in urology at the University of Rochester, 1961-67.

Theodore married Donna Lee Taylor, on July 5, 1958. Together, they raised three children here in the Valley of the Sun. When Donna passed away in 2018, they had been married for 59 years.

He served as a physician in the Army, 1962-63, obtaining the rank of Captain.

Dr. Mobley was a very well-respected leader in the Arizona medical community, which he joined in 1967, as a partner in the medical practice, Affiliated Urologists, through 1999. He served on the Board of Directors for the Maricopa County Medical Society, 1975-77, and as President of the Medical Staff for St. Joseph’s Hospital, 1980-83. He was also a founding member of the Phoenix Urological Society. In 2003, he joined the Veterans Administration’s Carl T. Hayden Hospital, where he continued to serve as a urologist until his death. He was Chair of the Institutional Review Board at the VA Hospital in 2010 and 2011.

Dr. Mobley was an avid sailor, hiker, and woodworker. He spent years hand-building a 40-foot wooden sailboat, La Bella Donna, on which he and Donna later enjoyed many cruising adventures on both coasts of the United States, as well as the Caribbean. He was a Steward for the Arizona Sonoran Desert Preserve, and an Usher for Pinnacle Presbyterian Church. More than anything, he provided love and sustenance for his family.

Grieving the loss of Theodore Mobley are his beloved daughter Margie Mobley and granddaughters Taylor, Brianna, and Chloe Mobley of Scottsdale; his daughter Mary Lou Mobley, son-in-law John Rummans, and grandson Matthew Rummans of Golden, CO; and his son James Mobley of Phoenix; as well as many, many beloved friends, peers, and relatives.
